# Tournament Timings



The club intends to avoid delays in games ending and starting the next. There will be runners to collect score cards from the referees and return them to the control room.

Please ensure if your team is the next game on a pitch, they are assembled at the nearest access gate to that pitch. Note U7-U10 games will be played using age specific goals. U11-14 using 9 a side goals.

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# Tournament Rules



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## **RULES for under 7 & 8 age group only (5 a-side)**

1. Each team is to consist of five players, plus up to 3 substitutes. Teams can have U7 and U8 players play in U8 teams only. U7 teams are for U7 players only.
2. The tournament is competitive and will play to semi finals and a final.
3. A player (subject to the provisions of rule 16) who has been replaced may return to the playing area as a substitute for another player at any time provided there are no more than five players on the pitch for the team at any one time.
4. The managers must ensure players are rotated and that each player should play for no more than 45 mins on the day.
5. No player can play in two age groups on the same day.
6. All players must be under their respective age limits as at 1st September 2018 and U7s must have attained the age of 6 as at midnight on the 31<sup>st</sup> August 2018 or have turned 6 in the playing season".
7. Any team playing an ineligible player will be disqualified.
8. Each game will be 8 minutes\* one-way and the retreat rule will apply. (\*The length of the games might have to be adjusted. Please enquire at registration.)
9. No offsides.
10. Goal kicks must be taken by the goalkeeper, by a drop kick or throw out and not a place kick.
11. The goalkeeper can handle anywhere in the goal area.
12. Normal rules of football will otherwise apply.
13. Shin pads must be worn. A size 3 ball will be used.

## **RULES for all other age groups (6 a-side)**

1. Each team is to consist of six players, plus up to two substitutes. Rolling substitutes are allowed.
2. No player can play in two age groups on the same day.
3. All players must be under their respective age limits as at 1st September 2018.
4. Any team playing an ineligible player will be disqualified.
5. Each game to be 8 minutes\* one way. All managers are responsible for ensuring their players are rotated and play for no more than 60 mins on the day. (\*The length of the games might have to be adjusted. Please enquire at registration.)
6. No offsides.
7. Goal kicks must be taken by a place kick from the goal line.
8. In 'Open Play' the Goalkeeper must return the ball into play with a throw out. The goalkeeper can handle anywhere in the goal area. He may roll the ball to himself and kick the ball into play but not a drop ball or half volley.

### **Normal rules of football will otherwise apply.**

9. Shin pads must be worn.
10. In League games - 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw.
11. If a team fail to appear, an automatic 1-0 win will be awarded to the opposition team.
12. The number of leagues, and qualification rules i.e. number of qualifying teams for the knock out stages will be formalised before the tournament once entry numbers are confirmed.
13. Group qualifiers will be decided by:
  - (a) Highest points won - 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw.
  - (b) Goal difference if teams are level on points.
  - (c) Greatest number of goals scored by a team if (b) is identical
  - (d) If (c) is identical it will be on the result of the group match between the teams.
  - (e) If (b), (c) and (d) are identical, goals conceded.
  - (g) Where teams are level on all of the above the group qualifiers will be decided by 2 minutes each way golden goal. If still level then penalties will take place, 3 for each team followed by sudden death if required.
14. If scores are level in a knock out match, the winner will be decided by 2 minutes each way golden goal. If still level then penalties will take place, 3 for each team followed by sudden death if required.





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# Tournament Rules

## **RULES for all age groups**

16. If a player is sent off in any match no substitute will be allowed during the rest of that game for that player. That player will also be banned for the rest of the tournament. If a player is booked in two different games he will be banned from the next game. A third booking and the player will be banned for the rest of the tournament. Any misconduct of a serious nature, including, but not restricted to, assault or being sent off for violent conduct, will be reported to the Wiltshire County FA who will take the appropriate action.

17. In the event of colours being similar the second named team in the fixture will be required to change.

18. The organisers will not be deemed responsible for any injury to any person, howsoever caused, throughout the tournament.

19. Any matter arising, which is not covered by these rules, will be dealt with by the Organising Committee.

20. In the event of the tournament, or any part of it, being cancelled money will be refunded equally among all teams affected after any expenses incurred have been met.

## **Tournament Guidelines**

The Manager of the winning team will be responsible for returning the result card to the control box if no runner is available.

Supporters / parents **MUST NOT** encroach onto the Ray Mac pitch. They are to stay in the stands around the pitch. Only Managers and players are allowed to enter the pitch area. Teams that are not currently playing a match are requested to remain in the stands.

Managers and coaches may not enter the playing field during the game unless invited by the referee.

Everyone is requested to remain at least 1m from the touchline during play.

Play by the tournament rules, with the right sporting attitude, win, lose or draw, please play for fun.

Please respect the referees' and officials' decisions, any verbal or physical abuse will be dealt with severely.

**DO NOT** bring animals to the stadium - you will be asked to remove them immediately.
